10. Challenges and corrective measures

Unfortunately Me Ntandokazi Mndela had to resign after one month as she was offered a full time job elsewhere. Helping hands will especially be needed if the SRIG application is successful.

Winter always results in considerably less weather windows available in which to sample.
 This could result in a sampling trip being cancelled for the month. Weather risks are mitigated by sending more than one team out into the field on the suitable days.
